Strike Action

The NEU, the largest teaching union, has announced two further days of strike action, Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.

At The Blake School, staff have indicated that they will strike on Wednesday 5th July, but **not** on Friday 7th July.

School will therefore be closed to all children on Wednesday 5th July and open to all children on Friday 7th July.

Teachers are striking to demand better funding for education.

Changes to the timing of the school day

From September 2023, all schools are required to be open to children for 6.5 hours. Though the additional time will certainly benefit children, as it will increase learning time, there has been no funding provided to schools to cover the costs of this additional 1.25 hours a week.

Currently the school day is 6.25 hours and so each school day needs to be increased by 15 minutes in order to comply with the government directive.

From September, the school day will therefore start at 8.50am, this means that doors to classrooms will shut and registers will be taken at that time. Children arriving after 8.50am will be late and will need to come into school via the front office. The school day will end at 3.20pm.

Breakfast club will start 10 minutes earlier, at 7.40am. After School Club will start 5 minutes later at 3.20pm.

Please make sure you have all upcoming end of term dates in your diary. Year 4 children have a Stone Age day on 4^{th} July. Also on 4^{th} July, children in Early Years and Years 1 - 3 have sports day (9.30 - 11.30).
