Safety around our site

Work on drains

On Thursday 11th December a team of drainage experts will be working to clear the last of our surface water drains. The works will begin before the start of the school day and will likely take most of the day.

The corner of the large car park (closest to the large playground gate) will be being used by the contractors. Our surface drains empty into the brook that runs between us and the farm and the work will therefore predominantly be taking place off site. Barriers will be in place to keep everyone safe.
