- Could I list the bonds to 5? (0+5, 1+4, 2+3, 4+1, 5+0) or even 10? (0+10, 1+9, 2+8, 3+7, 4+6, 5+5, 6+4, 7+3, 8+2, 9+1, 10+0)
- Do I remember what 'Place Value' means? (The value of each digit in a number, based on its position.)
- Can I tell you how many 'tens' and 'ones' are in the following numbers: 24 (2 tens, 4 ones), 36 (3 tens, 6 ones), 63 (6 tens, 3 ones), 17 (1 ten, 7 ones). You could ask me a few more if you like!
- Can I tell you what I understand about the word 'materials'? (Different materials are used to make/create/build different things, depending on their use.)
- What materials did we have to sort into groups in Science this week? (Cardboard, rubber/elastic, cork, wood, plastic, wool.)
- Can I share some repeated phrases from some of the Traditional Tales I know?
- Which repeated phrases did I write in a speech bubble in English?
- What story did I hear in the Outdoor Classroom? (Goldilocks and the Three Bears) Did I play a part?
- Do I think Goldilocks is a nice character? What can I tell you about her?
- What did we talk about in RE this week? (Are some stories more important than others?)

Blue group children need only practice blue spellings

Green group children can practice words for the green spellings, as well as blue spellings

Please also encourage children to write 1 or more sentences, using the spelling words, in their homework books, focusing on neat formation, capital letters and full stops.

Reading

If possible 5-10minutes each day. If your children need a reading book change - please remind them to put their book wallets in the 'book change' box in the morning.

Show and tell:

This usually follows an aspect of our learning in class and is held on Friday afternoons. We select 4/5 children per week to talk about, or bring something, in relation to that topic. The purpose is just to give the children a chance to build their confidence talking in front of a group but also, when it is topic related, to give them a chance to explore the topic further on their own. It is absolutely led by the children and there are no expectations. Some children will draw a picture, some will bring something in they feel fits - there are no wrong answers or ideas if it comes from the children.

This Terms Show and Tell - 'Things I love'

We want to find out what your children love! Let them pick 1 thing that they can share about. It needs to be something that <u>THEY</u> are passionate about and are interested in, and that they can share with their friends confidently. It would be a wonderful opportunity for the children to learn something new about each other. If children would rather not stand in front of the class, we could encourage them in a small group, or continue to work on these important skills through the term.
