School lunches

All of our meals are cooked fresh on site every day.

Our kitchen team work very hard to ensure that if children arrive late in school, or if there is a lost packed lunch, we are able to provide a hot dinner for them.

From time to time, children who have ordered a school lunch become poorly during the morning and have to go home.

If they leave school before 10am their lunch can be cancelled and no charge will be made for the lunch.

If however a child leaves after 10am it will be too late to cancel their meal and therefore the cost for this will be passed on to parents as if the child had remained in school.

Nits
