Positive Covid-19 cases in school

We now have positive Covid-19 cases in Reception, Year 2, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6. At the moment, other than in Year 5, these cases are mostly isolated.

In line with the government guidance and following conversations with Thames Valley Public Health and Public Health England, our key mitigations remain ventilation, vaccination and good hygiene.

As the weather does begin to cool, please do make sure that your child has warm clothing in school as we are aiming to ensure that there is always good airflow, whether in classrooms, or shared areas.

If your child has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, we would encourage you to take them for a PCR test. If your child is symptomatic, they should not come to school, but should go for a PCR test.

Birthdays

From this year, we are no longer distributing sweets on children's birthdays. Instead we are going to be encouraging the sharing of a favourite story book.

There will be more details about this in the next few weeks. In the meantime, if your child has a birthday, we will still be marking this in class and will be making sure their special day is celebrated.
